Describe the event. What happened? Why?	War between France and England over Ohio River Valley. England won.	King George III said colonist could not move past the Appalachian Mountain Chain.	Tax on written documents	4 strict rules enforced by King George III	Document written to the king declaring independence from England.
How did this lead to the American Revolution?	War led to debt for England and King George III taxed colonists.	This rule made colonists mad at the king.	Colonists got mad at the king for issuing more taxes.	Colonists continued to get mad because they thought the rules were too strict.	King George III sent troops to colonies in order to fight colonists so that they would remain his territories.
How did this affect Georgia?	Paying extra taxes make the colonist mad because they felt they weren't being equally represented in England's government.	This moved Georgia's southern border to the St. Mary's River	GA was the only colony to buy the stamps and this made other colonies view GA as weak.	The Quartering Act (a part of the Intolerable Acts) affected GA because it allowed British soldiers to stay in the colonist's home.	Georgia colonists will fight in this war and Georgia will see battles.
